Small groups engage our generations together and have some dedicated for certain folks. Some groups will pick a day/time that works best to meet, unless there is already an established time. Being a part of Trinity's community involves engaging in the life of church and this opportunity to build relationships. Please make this a priority!

Grace Tables (Monthly Sundays at 6:30 pm)

Non-Lutherans and non-Christians joined us. Pub Theology 2.0 will continue to wrestle with important **pub**-lic questions: i.e. Does truth telling really matter? Is faith cut and dried? Is conformation different than confirmation? Should Cristian nationalism really be the law of the land?
